Whereas, the petition of E. M. Goodwin having been duly filed with  
the Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court of Jefferson County, on the 11th day of April  
19 63, alleging that the named Francis Parker

a female child under eighteen years of age, is delinquent, dependent or neglected, and in need  
of the care and protection of the Court, in that she so deports her self, or is in such condition  
or surroundings, or is under such improper or insufficient guardianship or control as to endanger the morals,  
health or general welfare of said child; and said petition alleging further that petitioner further says  
that said child is delinquent in that within twelve months before the filing of this petition  
in the City of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, she did organize or hold or assist in  
holding or organizing, or take part or participate in a parade or procession or other public  
demonstration on the streets or other public ways of said city without a written permit  
therefor having first been obtained from the City Commission of said city, contrary to and  
in violation of the provisions of a duly enacted ordinance of said city, to-wit: Section  
1159 of the 1930 General Code of the City of Birmingham

and praying that summons issue thereon pursuant to statute, now, therefore,

You, Francis Parker, the above named child, are hereby  
summoned to appear before the Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court of Jefferson County, Alabama, to be in  
session at 120-2nd Court North, Birmingham, Alabama

on the 25th day of  
April, 19 63, at 9 o'clock in the fore noon, and you  
mother, Francis Parker, and you father, R. B. Parker

are hereby summoned to appear with the said child at  
the place and time above stated, each of you there and then to show cause why the said child should not be  
dealt with according to the provisions of the Code of Alabama, Title 62, Section 310 Et. Seq.
